

## College Reservoir Replacement in Yorba Linda

<b>What</b>	Replace existing 1.0MG partially buried concrete reservoir with (2) new 0.5MG above ground welded steel reservoirs.
<b>When</b>	Construction will begin in mid-June, 2020 to demolish existing concrete reservoir and replace with (2) new 0.5MG above ground welded steel reservoirs. Construction is anticipated to take approximately 14 to 16 months. Construction hours shall be 8:00AM to 5:00PM Monday through Friday.
<b>Where</b>	See enclosed map showing the location of the College Plant Site. This facility provides service to a portion of the City of Yorba Linda and unincorporated Orange County.
<b>What to Expect</b>	Construction crews with heavy excavators, breaker bars, backhoes, dump trucks, crew trucks and hand tools will be digging throughout the plant site. The streets will remain open to traffic during the construction period. Local traffic on Bastanchury Road near the access road entrance, may be restricted periodically for short durations of time to get large equipment and materials in and out of the site. The construction crews will make every effort to keep dust to a minimum. Please expect an increased level of noise during the construction period, particularly during demolition of the existing structure.
