



CUSTOMERS REMINDED TO TURN OFF WATER & OUTDOOR IRRIGATION TIMERS DURING WILDFIRE EVACUATIONS

Given Lake County's recent history with catastrophic wildfires, the region's water providers are reminding customers to take the important step of turning off their water and outdoor irrigation timers when evacuating their homes and businesses during a wildfire emergency.

Limiting unnecessary water use during a wildfire emergency is critical to ensure water resources are available for fire protection activities in the community, and makes it easier for crews working to restore disabled utilities.
