



## 24-Hour Drilling Scheduled to Continue Dec. 10 for Well Project on Fairhaven Avenue in Orange

Golden State Water Company (Golden State Water) is notifying customers and the surrounding community of 24-hour drilling and pump testing scheduled to continue Dec. 10, 2018, as part of a groundwater well construction project on the south side of Fairhaven Avenue in Orange. The 24-hour drilling and pump testing activities are expected to last through mid-January, with intermittent breaks to accommodate holiday schedules. There will be a break in the construction activities Dec. 24 through Jan. 1. Sound barriers have been erected at the construction site to mitigate disturbance and limit inconvenience to residents for the duration of the project.

Local water service will not be interrupted during the construction. Golden State Water thanks customers and the surrounding community for their patience as it completes this important construction project.


The Fairhaven Well No. 3 Drilling and Testing project began in September 2018 and is scheduled to be completed in February 2019, weather permitting. When equipped, the well will provide a new groundwater source for the local water system and ensure the utility can continue providing reliable water service to the Cowan Heights community for generations to come.

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### What you can expect:

Several steps have been taken to minimize the project's impact on customers:

- Local water service will not be interrupted during the drilling and testing phase of the project; however, residents near the Fairhaven Well No. 3 drill site will experience a temporary increase in ambient noise during the drilling, testing and well construction period scheduled to be completed in February 2019, weather permitting.
- 24-hour drilling and pump testing will continue Dec. 10 and is expected to last through mid-January, with intermittent breaks to accommodate holiday schedules.
- After the 24-hour drilling and construction phase of the project, normal working hours will be between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Sound attenuation barriers will be utilized to mitigate sound disturbance during the drilling and testing phase of the project.
- All local streets adjacent to the project site will remain open throughout the project; however, traffic and parking may be restricted periodically in order to move heavy equipment on and off the project site.
- Golden State Water appreciates your patience as it completes this important project.
