Subject: 2019 Interim Rate Revenue Shortfall True-up - Region 3

PURPOSE

GSWC is seeking authorization to implement a temporary surcharge in its Region 3 CSAs to recover the revenue shortfall caused by the variance between interim rates (which were in place since January 1, 2019) and final rates implemented on June 8, 2019, via Advice Letter No. 1773-W. The final rates in Region 3 were adopted in California Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Decision No. ("D.") 19-05-044, dated May 30, 2019, for GSWC's General Rate Case Application No. 17-07-010.

Ordering Paragraph No. 40 in D. 19-05-044 authorizes GSWC to file the above referenced tariff sheets. Specifically, Ordering Paragraph No. 40 states,

Golden State Water Company shall file a tier 2 Advice Letter for the disposition of the balance accumulated in the Interim Rates Memorandum Account within 90 days of the date of adoption of this decision.

GSWC has calculated the difference between the interim rates and final rates for the period of January 1, 2019 through June 7, 2019. As shown in the supporting workpapers, the total revenue shortfall in the Region 3 CSAs is \$156,941.

TEMPORARY SURCHARGE

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 40, GSWC is requesting to recover the revenue shortfall over a 12-month period. All metered water sales under Rate Schedule

Nos. R3-1-R, R3-1-NR, R3-CM-7ML, R3-CMH-3M, R3-OC-3M, R3-SD-3, and R3- RCW will be impacted as follows:

Temporary Surcharge of \$0.007/Ccf for a 12-month period.

Supporting workpapers detailing the rate design calculations for the amortization have been provided to the Water Division.

COMPLIANCE

This advice letter reflects GSWC's compliance with the directives in the Ordering Paragraph No. 40 from D. 19-05-044.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D. 19-05-044, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective on September 27, 2019.

CUSTOMER NOTICE

GSWC will include a bill message on the customer's first bill after the increase goes into effect to inform its Region 3 customers of this compliance rate increase.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or

6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.


