Subject: General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account - Region 3 Amortization Request

PURPOSE

GSWC is seeking authorization to amortize the amount recorded in the General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account - Region 3 ("GRABA-R3"), via a one-time surcredit to all ratepayers in the Region 3 ratemaking areas. GSWC is requesting to refund the \$459,358 over-collection recorded in the GRABA-R3, to the Region 3 customers. If the proposed surcredits are not issued now and are addressed in GSWC's next General Rate Case, customers in Region 3 would wait until January 1, 2022 at the earliest to receive the one-time surcredit on their water bill.

BACKGROUND

On May 30, 2019, the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. ("D.") 19-05-044, resolving GSWC's 2017 GRC Application No. 17-07-010.

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in D.19-05-044, GSWC filed Advice Letter No. 1774-W to establish the Preliminary Statement, Part IIII, General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account ("GRABA") for each ratemaking area. Specifically, Ordering Paragraph No. 12 states, in part,

Golden State Water Company is authorized to establish a General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account (GRABA) for each ratemaking area, and to file a Tier 1 advice letter to add a preliminary statement that is substantially similar to the relevant draft preliminary statement in Appendix J of the Settlement Agreement attached to this decision.

GENERAL RATEMAKING AREA BALANCING ACCOUNT

The purpose of the GRABA is to aggregate small residual dollar amounts from expired authorized amortizations and other authorized dollar amounts (e.g. intervener compensation awards) for subsequent amortization at the ratemaking area level. A small residual balance would encompass any balance less than 2% of gross adopted revenues by ratemaking area. The GRABA became effective on June 8, 2019.

On October 1, 2019, GSWC filed Advice Letter No. 1792-W to transfer the small, residual balances in various balancing and memorandum accounts to the GRABA in compliance

with D.19-05-044. Upon completion of the audit of the residual balances by Commission staff, GSWC transferred the \$457,982 over-collection recorded in Region 3, as of August 31, 2019, to the GRABA-R3. Advice Letter No. 1792-W became effective October 31, 2019.

GRABA-R3 CUSTOMER REFUND

As of October 31, 2019, GSWC recorded an over-collection of \$459,358¹ in the GRABA-R3. GSWC is seeking authorization to refund this amount to all water customers in its Region 3 ratemaking areas, via a one-time surcredit (refund) to their monthly service charge. Preliminary Statement, Part IIII, states GSWC can amortize the GRABA by a Tier 2 advice letter if the accumulated balance exceeds 2% of the adopted gross revenues or in its next general rate case application. The balance in the GRABA-R3 does not exceed the 2% threshold, however, GSWC believes refunding this over-collection to customers now, as opposed to waiting for a final decision in its 2020 GRC application, would be a benefit to the Region 3 customers.

BILL IMPACT

If this advice letter is approved, customers with a $5/8" \times 3/4"$ meter on Schedule No. R3-1-R or Schedule No. R3-1-NR would receive a one-time refund of \$2.73.

Customers who are served by other meter sizes and/or rate schedules other than residential or non-residential will receive a one-time surcredit, as listed on their respective water rate schedules.

WORKPAPERS

Supporting workpapers detailing the calculations and rate design for the proposed surcredits are being supplied to the Water Division and the Public Advocates Office for review.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

This is not a compliance advice letter, as such, GSWC is required to submit an executed Customer Notification Verification with this advice letter. A copy of the Customer Notice Verification with the drafted bill message language is attached to this advice letter.

TIER DESIGNATION

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC is requesting this advice letter become effective on January 1, 2020.

¹Interest accrues in the GRABA on a monthly basis by applying a rate equal to one-twelfth of the 3-month Commercial Paper Rate*, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, to the average of the beginning-of-month and the end-of-month balances.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

- 5. Quantity Fee for Recycled Water. GSW shall not assess a quantity fee for the quantity of recycled water used by the Cemetery for irrigation purposes.
- 6. Potable Water Quantity Fee. Should the Cemetery use potable water supplied by GSW for irrigation purposes following commencement of the use of recycled water for such purposes, GSW shall charge Forest Lawn and Forest Lawn shall pay to GSW a fee per hundred cubic feet of potable water served to the Cemetery ("Potable Water Quantity Fee"), which shall reimburse GSW for the variable costs of supplying potable water supplies to the Cemetery for Potable Water Quantity Fee shall initially be equal to forty-nine irrigation purposes. The percent (49%) ("Variable Cost Percentage") of GSW's Generally applicable water quantity fee pursuant to GSW's tariff schedule R3-1 or successor tariff. The initial Variable Cost Percentage is set forth in Advice Letter No. 1217-W.
- 7. The Variable Cost Percentage shall be adjusted, as necessary, concurrently with the effective date of each future change in GSW's CPUC-approved tariff schedule R3-1 or successor tariff. The methodology for said Variable Cost Percentage adjustment shall be the same as that set forth in Exhibit B to the Agreement attached to Advice Letter No. 1217-W.
- 8. Meter Service Cost. Forest Lawn shall reimburse GSW for any and all actual costs incurred by GSW in replacing the meters associated with providing potable water to the Cemetery for irrigation purposes, when such replacement is, in GSW's sole determination, necessary.
- 9. Potable Water Supplies During Drought Period Conditions; Rationing. The Parties acknowledge that the substitution of recycled water for a significant portion of the Cemetery's irrigation needs will result in a lower historical baseline of potable water service to the Cemetery in the future. GSW agrees that should it employ a rationing program during drought periods, which sets water supply allocations based upon historical baseline water use, Forest Lawn will be assigned an effective annual baseline use equal to its actual annual use of recycled and table water during any baseline period.

10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a one-time credit of \$136.47 is to be applied to the customer's bill beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1807-W. The one-time credit will refund the over-collection in the General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account-Region 3. (N)
