Subject: Robbins Tax Memorandum Account Closure

#### **PURPOSE**

GSWC seeks authorization from the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), as has been requested of it by the Water Division, to close and remove Preliminary Statement, Part NNNN, Robbins Tax Memorandum Account from its tariff book, subject to its right to apply for reinstatement of the RTMA should an unforeseen tax consequence adverse to it occurs.

# **BACKGROUND**

On July 15, 2021, GSWC filed Advice Letter No. 1860-W with the Commission to establish the Robbins Tax Memorandum Account ("RTMA"), pursuant to Resolution No. W-5237. The purpose of the RTMA is to track tax liabilities and expenses (including costs associated therewith) resulting from approval of GSWC's proposed actions in its advice letter filing to acquire the Robbins Water System that are not otherwise provided for in a general rate case application or decision, including, but not limited to, taxes resulting from principal forgiveness of loan proceeds as a result of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 ("TCJA") having amended Internal Revenue Code Section 118 such that government grants for constructing, repairing, expanding, or upgrading infrastructure are taxable after TCJA's enactment. Advice Letter No. 1860-W became effective on August 1, 2021.

On November 15, 2021, H.R. 3684, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("Act") was signed into law (P.L. 117-58). Act Sec. 80601 restores the exception for contributions in aid of construction ("CIAC") received by regulated water and sewerage disposal utilities ("water-CIAC exception") that was struck by TCJA. Consequently, GSWC no longer expects that its future receipt of DDW SAFER program principal-forgiveness grant funds will be subject to federal taxation as it would have been prior to the enactment of P.L. 117-58. As a primary consideration for establishing the RTMA was the absence of the water-CIAC exception, GSWC appreciates Water Division's desire for GSWC to request Commission approval to close the Account. Given the inherent uncertainties in tax law and its interpretation by taxing authorities, as well as the appropriately broad scope of the approved RTMA for tax matters, including audit defense costs, GSWC reserves its right to apply for reinstatement of the RTMA should an unforeseen tax consequence adverse to it occurs. The recent history of the abruptness and unexpectedness of TCJA's repeal of the water-CIAC exception demonstrates the prudency of such adaptability.

GSWC has not recorded any entries into the RTMA since its inception, so there are no funds to be disposed of.

# **REQUEST**

For the reasons stated above, GSWC is seeking to close and remove Preliminary Statement, Part NNNN, Robbins Tax Memorandum Account from its tariff book.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This advice letter has a Tier 1 designation. GSWC is requesting this filing have an effective date of April 6, 2022.

#### **CUSTOMER NOTICE**

There are no rate modifications requested in this advice letter, therefore, a customer notice is not required.

#### **RESPONSE OR PROTEST**

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;

- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

The purpose of the Robbins Tax Memorandum Account ("RTMA") is to track tax liabilities and expenses (including costs associated therewith) resulting from approval of GSWC's proposed actions in its advice letter filing to acquire the Robbins Water System that are not otherwise provided for in a general rate case application or decision, including, but not limited to, taxes resulting from principal forgiveness of loan proceeds as a result of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 ("TCJA") having amended Internal Revenue Code Section 118 such that government grants for constructing, repairing, expanding, or upgrading infrastructure are taxable after TCJA's enactment. Other examples of costs applicable for memo account tracking include those, if any, associated with the initial acquisition of the Robbins Water System, including those that a taxing authority may issue an assessment for, penalties or interest thereon, and audit defense costs associated with the actions approved in Advice Letter 1818-W, and property-tax liabilities.

Recovery of the estimated tax liability resulting from the State Water Resources Control Board's principal forgiveness loan to GSWC to construct a new well and treatment facility within the Robbins Water System will be recorded in the RTMA. GSWC will implement a temporary surcharge that will be applied to all GSWC rate schedules across its entire customer base until the tax liability is fully recovered

<u>General Information</u>. Upon its acquisition of the Robbins Water System, an Inadequately Operated and Maintained Small Publicly-Owned Water Utility, GSWC shall record tax liabilities and expenses (including costs associated therewith) in the RTMA.

#### 1. Accounting Procedure

The RTMA does not have a rate component.

#### 2. Expenditure Entries

A debit entry shall be made on a monthly basis to the RTMA to record any tax liability and expense resulting from approval of Golden State's proposed actions in its advice letter filing to acquire the Robbins Water System that are not otherwise provided for in a general rate case application or decision.

#### 3. Interest

Interest shall accrue on the RTMA balance, by applying a rate equal to one-twelfth of the 3-month Commercial Paper Rate, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, to the average of the beginning-of-month and the end-of month balances.

#### 4. Effective Date

The RTMA shall go into effect on the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1860-W.

#### 5. Disposition of RTMA Balance.

Disposition of amounts recorded in the RTMA shall be determined in GSWC's next General Rate Case application, or as otherwise determined by the Commission if the account's cumulative balance exceeds 2% of GSWC's adopted gross revenues.
