In accordance with Ordering Paragraph No. 5 in Decision No. 23-06-025, GSWC is filing this advice letter to implement rate changes to reflect the newly adopted Cost of Capital for GSWC. This advice letter is designated a Tier 1 Advice Letter.

## **Background**

On June 29, 2023, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) adopted D.23-06-025, in Application No. 21-05-003, the consolidated Cost of Capital proceeding for GSWC, San Jose Water Company, California-American Water Company and California Water Service Company. This decision, among other things, provides a rate of return of 7.24% for GSWC for years 2022, 2023 and 2024.

Ordering Paragraph No. 3 in D. 23-06-025 establishes costs of capital (debt and equity), capital structures and rates of return for GSWC for the period 2022-2024 as follows:

Prior to the issuance of D.23-06-025, GSWC's authorized rate of return was 7.91%.

Additionally, D.23-06-025 authorized the continuation of the Water Cost of Capital Mechanism, adopted in D.09-07-051 and D.12-07-051, D.18-03-035, which includes a 100 basis point dead band, plus and minus, before an adjustment occurs, provides a reasonable adjustment to the return on equity and should be used for any adjustment to the base year 2022 ratemaking return on common equity for the subsequent years 2023 and 2024.

GSWC filed Advice Letter 1897-W to propose an adjusted 2023 Cost of Capital Structure based on the trigger rate being higher than the benchmark by 103 basis points. Incorporating the new ROE into the authorized capital structure results in a revised total rate of return on rate base of 7.53%<sup>1</sup>, an increase of 29 basis points from its previous authorized level of 7.24%.

The proposed 2023 Cost of Capital Structure adjusted ROE of 7.53 % request has been reviewed and approved by the Commission.

## Compliance

Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of D.23-06-025 adopts GSWC's Cost of Capital Rate Structure for 2022, 2023, and 2024. GSWC is filing this Tier 1 advice letter to implement the adjusted rate changes to reflect the adopted Cost of Capital and corresponding revenue requirement adjustments.

GSWC will provided the Water Division and the Public Advocates Office with supporting workpapers.

## **Customer Notice**

This is a Tier 1 advice letter that does not require customer notification, as provided in Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B. However, GSWC will include a bill message on each of its customers' first bills generated after the rate change goes into effect to inform them of this rate decrease.

## **Effective Date**

GSWC is requesting that this advice letter and the tariffs become effective on July 31, 2023.

## **Response or Protest**

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.** 

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

WD must receive a response or protest via email (<u>or</u> postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.** The addresses for submitting a response or protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

## **Replies**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by WD within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL. The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.
