To the California Public Utilities Commission:

Golden State Water Company (GSWC) hereby transmits the attached tariff sheets applicable to its Region 3, Claremont Customer Service Area (CSA).

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B Water Industry Rule 7.3.2., this advice letter is designated as a Tier 2 Advice Letter.

Purpose

GSWC requests to terminate Schedule No. R3-CMH-3M, Measured Irrigation Service and Schedule No. R3-CMP-3M, Metered Irrigation Service and to remove these Schedules from its Tariff Book.

Discussion

GSWC requests authorization to terminate and close its Schedule No. R3-CMH-3M, in its Region 3's Claremont CSA. The four customers served under this rate schedule will now be served under Schedule No. R3-1-NR, Non-Residential Metered Service.

Background

At its inception, Schedule No. R3-CMH-3M¹ was established specifically for commercial crop production utilizing untreated water. The physical water service was originally acquired by GSWC² from the Claremont Heights Irrigation Company. At that time, approximately 20 customers were active under this schedule; today, only four (4) remain.

When the schedule was established and approved by the California Public Utilities Commission, the following special conditions were included:

"Special Condition 7:³*This service is limited to existing irrigation customers of record who irrigate all or a reasonable part of their acreage each and every year.****Special Condition 9:****This service shall be terminated when either the number of irrigation customers of record is less than five OR the total irrigated acreage is less than ten acres."*

Additionally, this rate is not transferable to new property owners (i.e., following the sale of the property). Our records confirm that only four (4) active original customers remain under the R3-CMH-3M rate and the total irrigated acreage for all properties is 6.3 acres which is less than ten (10) acres.

Based on these conditions, GSWC has terminated Schedule R3-CMH-3M. The affected irrigation water services were transitioned to Schedule No. R3-1-NR, effective July 1, 2026.

The four (4) customers on this rate schedule were notified of the termination of this rate and the transition of their account to the non-residential rate schedule in January 2026, via a letter sent by U.S. Postal service.

Additionally, GSWC is removing Schedule No. R3-CMP-3M from its Tariff book, the last customer on this rate schedule closed their account in February 2009 and the rate has been closed to any new customers.

Effective Date

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective on August 12, 2026.

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by WD within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Within the City of Claremont, in Los Angeles County, bounded on the east by the County Line, on the south by Bluefield Drive and its easterly extension, on the west by Bonnie Brea Avenue and its northerly extension, on the north by the westerly extension of 21st Street.

RATES

Quantity Rates:

For all water delivered, per 100 cu. ft. \$ 0.813

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. This service is limited to existing irrigation customers of record who irrigate all or a reasonable part of their acreage each and every year.
3. The utility does not represent or guarantee that any water delivered hereunder is potable or of a quality suitable for human consumption. Any customer who uses said water or makes it available to others for human consumption shall take all necessary precautions to make the same potable and shall assume all risks and liabilities in connection therewith.
4. The utility does not guarantee a continuous and uninterrupted supply under this schedule and reserves the right to temporarily suspend the delivery of water when it is necessary to take the whole or part of the system out of service for the purpose of cleaning, maintaining and repairing or other essential improvements thereon; or for domestic purpose.
5. The utility is not required to provide service under this schedule for the watering of lawns, golf courses, parks, memorial parks or cemeteries.
6. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.147 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customer's bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.045 per Ccf based on an 18-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on May 1, 2025 as indicated in Advice Letter 1958-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.264 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on October 10, 2023. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023.
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in an amount of \$0.085 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on May 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2025 through January 31, 2025.
10. Beginning January 1, 2026, as required by Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code, an increase in purchased water of \$0.32271/Ccf, an increase in purchased power of \$0.00691/kwh, an increase in pump tax costs of \$0.02946/Ccf, and an increase in lease water costs of \$0.12604/Ccf relative to costs adopted by Decision No. 25-01-036, and an associated revenue increase of 2.18 %, are being tracked in a reserve account.
11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.0060 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on April 3, 2026. The surcharge recovers the balance in the MWRAM and ICBA.
