Hunting Horn Plant: Replace Reservoir

What	Replace Concrete Reservoir at Hunting Horn Plant
When	Replacement of existing potable water storage reservoir is scheduled to occur from September 15, 2022 through August 31, 2023 between 8 AM and 5 PM.
Where	11272 Reservoir Road in North Tustin, California.
What to Expect	Construction crews with crane, backhoes, dump trucks, crew trucks will be moving on and off the plant site. Contractor will be replacing the existing concrete reservoir within the footprint and form of the existing structure, and upgrading reservoir connection piping. During the phases of construction, you will hear general construction noise and heavy equipment operating during normal business hours. During construction, the easterly branch of Reservoir Road ("Reservoir Road East") will be temporarily closed to through-traffic to provide a laydown and staging area – to enable streamlining of materials delivery and installation, which should reduce the impact and duration of the construction work. Access to residential driveways will be maintained. During the demolition phase there will be some jackhammer and backhoe work; this will be when the most noise is expected. The construction crews will make every effort to keep dust to a minimum. Please expect an increased level of noise during the construction period. Weekly activities such as trash pick up will not be interrupted.
