Concerto Plant: Decommission of Well #2

What	Decommission of Concerto Well #2 and On-site Facilities at Concerto Plant.
When	Work will commence on January 2022 with completion expected by May 2022. Working hours will be Monday – Friday, from 8:00 AM to 5: 00 PM
Where	Concerto Plant: 1736 Concerto Drive in Anaheim, California.
What to Expect	Construction crews with backhoes, dump trucks, crew trucks will be moving on and off plant site. Contractor will be decommissioning the well by sealing the well with cement and utilizing shot perforations. During the phases of construction, you will hear general construction noise and heavy equipment operating during normal business hours. During the shot perforation you will hear a signal air horn to alert everyone on site, a small pop may be heard when the perforations are shot and then an air horn signaling the all clear. During the final decommissioning phase there will be some jackhammer and backhoe work, this will be when the most noise will be made. Finally, contractor will load up all materials and the well decommissioning will be complete. The streets will remain open to traffic during the construction period. The construction crews will make every effort to keep dust to a minimum. Please expect an increased level of noise during the construction period. Weekly activities such as trash pick up will not be interrupted.
