



## 24-Hour Drilling Scheduled to Begin Feb. 4 for Well Project on East Pomello Drive in Claremont

Golden State Water Company (Golden State Water) is notifying customers and the surrounding community of 24-hour drilling and zone testing scheduled to begin Feb. 4, 2019, as part of a groundwater well construction project at 928 E. Pomello Dr. in Claremont. The 24-hour drilling and zone testing activities are expected to last up to 10 days at a time. Sound barriers at the construction site should mitigate any disturbance and limit inconvenience to neighbors. There will be a break in the construction activities from Feb. 14-21.

Local water service will not be interrupted during the construction. Golden State Water thanks customers and the surrounding community for their patience as it completes this important construction project.

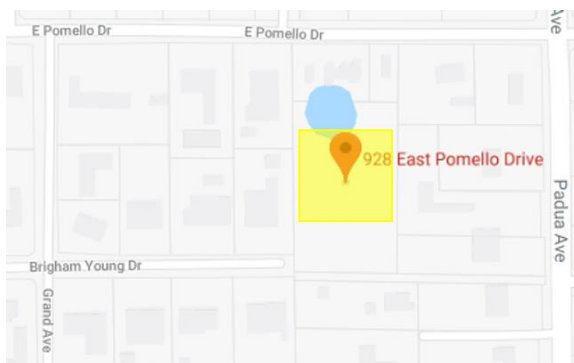
The Pomello Well No. 5 Drilling and Testing project began in December 2018 and is scheduled to be completed in March 2019. When equipped, the well will provide a new groundwater source for the local water system and ensure the utility can continue providing reliable water service to the Claremont community for generations to come.

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### What you can expect:

Several steps have been taken to minimize the project's impact on the community:

- Local water service will not be interrupted during the drilling and testing phase of the project; however, residents near the Pomello Well No. 5 drill site may experience a temporary increase in ambient noise during the drilling, testing and well construction period from February-March 2019.
- 24-hour drilling and zone testing will begin Feb. 4 and is expected to last up to 10 days at a time through Feb. 28, with intermittent breaks in the 24/7 schedule.
- After the 24-hour drilling and construction phase of the project, normal working hours will be resumed. Golden State Water will keep customers apprised of the construction schedule as the project progresses.
- Sound attenuation barriers will be utilized to mitigate sound disturbance during the drilling and testing phase of the project.
- All local streets adjacent to the project site will remain open throughout the project; however, traffic and parking may be restricted periodically in order to move heavy equipment on and off the project site.
- Golden State Water appreciates your patience as it completes this important project.
