**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. As authorized by Rule 9.1.e. for customers with more than one meter on a single service line, the customer's service charge rate is based on a factor multiplied by the service charge applicable to the nearest standard meter size of the combined meters as determined by the equivalent diameter methodology.
3. Non-residential Sprinkler rates can be added as needed utilizing the multiplication factors identified in Appendix F of Decision No. 16-12-067, applied to the 5/8" meter charge.
4. Pursuant to Decision 05-07-045, to recover the balance as of January 31, 2005 in the Water Quality Litigation Memorandum Account, a surcharge of \$0.333 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate through August 31, 2025.
5. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.166 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customer's bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.
6. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.196 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on October 13, 2023. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.186 per Ccf based on an 12-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on May 1, 2025 as indicated in Advice Letter 1958-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account. (D)

8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in an amount of \$0.057 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on May 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2025 through January 31, 2025. (L)

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge will be applied to customer bills for the remainder of a 20-year loan obligation that began in March 2013 to repay a \$8.6 million loan Golden State Water Company received under the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 from the California Department of Public Health to fund the Meter Installation and Retrofit Program in the Arden-Cordova District, pursuant to Commission Resolution No. W-4810. The specific recalibrated surcharges below went into effect on November 11, 2018. (T)
