**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. New Services: Contra Costa Water District (CCWD) imposes a Facilities Reserve Charge for new or enlarged retail services in this district. An applicant for service must first pay this fee, if applicable, to CCWD before service will be rendered under this schedule.
3. Residential customers are defined as all single-family customers with one dwelling unit that are individually metered.
4. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.166 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.
5. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.565 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on October 10, 2023. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023. (D)
6. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.083 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on May 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2025 through January 31, 2025. (D)
7. Beginning January 1, 2026, as required by Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code, an increase in purchased water of \$0.17272/Ccf relative to the purchased water adopted by Decision No. 25-01-036 and a decrease in purchased power of \$0.00243/kwh, relative to the purchased power adopted by approval of supply offset in Advice Letter 1960-W, and an associated revenue increase of 1.56%, are being tracked in a reserve account. (D)
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.0011 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on April 3, 2026. The surcharge recovers the balance in the M-WRAM and ICBA. (N)
