


\$5.2 Million Pipe Replacement Project in Lawndale

Golden State Water Company (Golden State Water) would like to thank our customers in the City of Lawndale for their patience as crews work to complete a \$5.2 million pipeline replacement project in your community.

Project Overview:

The project includes the installation of more than 15,250 feet of new PVC pipe, 550 water services, and 22 fire hydrants to improve the distribution system and ensure Golden State Water can continue providing reliable water service to local customers.

The final phases of the project, which will commence in the coming month, will include reconnecting domestic services, abandoning the old main and restoring



roadways with permanent asphalt. These final road repairs will begin after the pipeline installation phase is complete.

Timeline: November 2018 - end of July 2019

Location: The new pipeline will be installed on 159th Street and 160th Street from Inglewood Ave. to Grevillea Ave.; on 161st, 162nd, 163rd, 164th and 165th streets from Inglewood Ave. to Hawthorne Blvd.; on Inglewood Ave. from 159th Street to 165th Street; and on Grevillea Ave. from 159th Street to 162nd Street.

Golden State Water appreciates the community's patience as it completes this important project. Project Details:

- The project will generally take place from Monday to Friday between the working hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- While the project is underway, local residents may notice sections of roadway that appear unfinished. Please note that this is only temporary paving while Golden State Water works to complete the project. Once completed, Golden State Water will restore the road, placing permanent asphalt on the surface.
- Streets will remain open to traffic during the construction period, but minor delays should be expected during certain construction tasks, such as installing the main pipelines and paving. Traffic and parking may be restricted and access to driveways may be temporarily limited for short durations of time. Traffic control will be implemented during the normal working hours.
- Please expect an increased level of noise and traffic during the construction period.
