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**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.166 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.
3. As authorized by Rule 9.1.e. for customers with more than one meter on a single service line, the customer's service charge rate is based on a factor multiplied by the service charge applicable to the nearest standard meter size of the combined meters as determined by the equivalent diameter methodology.
4. Non-residential Sprinkler rates can be added as needed utilizing the multiplication factors identified in Appendix F of D. 16-12-067, applied to the 5/8" meter charge.
5. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.547 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on July 31, 2023. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Los Osos Groundwater Adjudication Memorandum Account as of September 30, 2020.
6. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$1.199 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on October 10, 2023. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.409 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 24-months, beginning on July 31, 2023. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Los Osos Basin Management Memorandum Account, as of September 30, 2020.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.858 per Ccf based on an 18-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on May 1, 2025 as indicated in Advice Letter 1958-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account. (I)
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.720 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 24-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Los Osos Groundwater Adjudication Memorandum Account as of May 31, 2023.

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**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.914 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Los Osos Basin Management Memorandum Account as of May 31, 2023.
11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.099 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the San Luis Obispo Valley Groundwater Basin Memorandum Account.
12. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.006 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the General Ratemaking Area Balancing Account.
13. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.001 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the CEMA - Emergency Disaster Relief Customer Outreach.
14. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.023 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the CEMA - COVID 19.
15. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.018 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Public Safety Power Shut-Off Memorandum Account.
16. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.003 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Memorandum Account.
17. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.016 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the 2021 Water Conservation Memorandum Account.
18. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.014 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Drinking Water Fees Balancing Account.
