SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. Pursuant to Decision No. 19-05-044 and Advice Letter No. 1842-W, a surcharge of \$0.095 per Ccf will be applied to all metered Customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CARW credit. This surcharge will offset the CARW credits and CARW administrative program costs recorded in the CARW Balancing Account. (R)
3. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.814 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a 36-month period from the effective date of Advice Letter 1771-W, which is June 8, 2019. This surcharge will amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Los Osos Groundwater Adjudication Memorandum Account, (LOAMA) as of May 2017.
4. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$1.297 per Ccf based on an 18-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on March 25, 2020 as indicated in Advice Letter 1813-WA. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM&MCBA Balancing Account.
