

Los Osos Customer Service Area Rebates and Programs

For ALL GSWC Customers in Los Osos & Edna Service Areas

Golden State Water Company is pleased to provide rebates as described below. Funding is limited and programs can close at any time. Most programs only allow specific approved high efficiency products to be purchased and installed. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us at conservationdept@gswater.com.

GSWC Residential Programs

GSWC rebates can be combined with SLO County rebates but through a separate application to GSWC. If combining, customers must adhere to the County program requirements for pre-inspections and application process.

CA State Turf Removal Program

While funding lasts, residential customers can apply to the Statewide Turf Removal Rebate Program managed by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR).

State funds are limited and are expected to go quickly. Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Customers are encouraged to apply as soon as possible at www.saveourwaterrebates.com.

**Check with your local planning departments before applying as some cities do not allow this type of landscape conversion or may require permits and plan check.*

Toilet Rebates

High-Efficiency Toilet rebates (HET) rebates are no longer available from GSWC for toilets that flush 1.28 gallons per flush. These toilets are now part of state code and are widely available. GSWC is encouraging customers to install Premium High-Efficiency Toilets (PHET) that are 20% more efficient than current HETs. All approved qualifying models have been tested and certified through the EPA Water Sense program.

Premium High Efficiency Toilet (PHET) Rebate

- Up to \$80 each limited to the cost of the toilet (installation not included)
- New toilet must flush 1.06 gallons per flush or less
- Must be replacing a toilet flushing 1.6 gallons per flush or more
- New toilet must be on the approved EPA WaterSense list found [HERE](#)
- Limit 2 per household

High Efficiency Clothes Washer (HECW) Rebate

- Up to \$80 for qualifying models on the list found [HERE](#)

Weather-Based Irrigation Controllers (Smart Controllers) Rebate

- Up to \$80 for approved models found [HERE](#)

Efficient Sprinkler Nozzle Rebate

- Up to \$4 per nozzle with a minimum purchase of 15
- Approved model list found [HERE](#)

Rain Barrel Rebate

- Receive \$35 per rain barrel purchased and installed
- Maximum of 3 barrels with a minimum of 50 gallons each
- Must submit pictures of installed rain barrels with rebate application

GSWC Commercial/Institutional and Large Landscape Programs

Premium High Efficiency Toilets (gravity and flush valve types)

- Up to \$80 for qualifying tank type models found [HERE](#)
- Flush valve models must flush 1.06 gallons or less to qualify
- Replacing valves only does not qualify. Must replace toilet and valve

High Efficiency Urinals (low and zero water use)

- Up to \$200 for qualifying models found [HERE](#)

Weather-Based (Smart) Irrigation Controllers

- Up to \$80 for sites less than 1 acre
- Up to \$25 per valve for sites more than one acre
- Approved model list [HERE](#)

Efficient nozzles and rotors

- Up to \$4 each nozzle with a minimum purchase of 15
- Up to \$13 per rotor pair with a minimum purchase of 8 pair

W-9 Tax Form Requirement

Federal IRS tax law requires water rebate program participants that receive \$600 or more in rebates in a calendar year to report that gain on their tax form. GSWC may issue a 1099 form on any rebate(s) totaling \$600 or more. Submission of a W-9 form is required prior to issuance of any rebate(s) totaling \$600 or more. Download the W-9 form [HERE](#).

San Luis Obispo County Los Osos Water Conservation Program

Customers residing within the Los Osos Wastewater Service Area can apply with the San Luis Obispo County Los Osos Water Conservation Program for customers to receive rebates for water efficient products and systems such as grey water and hot water recirculation.

It is the customer's responsibility to understand and follow all program rules and requirements to have their applications approved. For County rebates, before purchasing and installing, you must apply first for pre-qualification:

1. Schedule a pre-inspection
2. Purchase and install
3. Schedule post-inspection

There is also an option for a Plumber Installed Service.
