\$2.1 MILLION MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN CULVER CITY SCHEDULED TO COMMENCE APRIL 5, 2021

Golden State Water Company (Golden State Water) is alerting the Culver City community of a \$2.1 million main replacement installation project that is scheduled to commence on April 5, 2021.

During the seven-month period through October 2021, crews will install more than 2,700 feet of new water main along the roadways, replace 47 services and install eight new fire hydrants. The project will ensure that Golden State Water can continue providing reliable water service and supporting fire protection for customers in the area.

Project Details

- Golden State Water is replacing the existing mains with PVC pipe along the following roadways:
 - Sepulveda Boulevard between Washington Boulevard, to Braddock Drive
 - Culver Boulevard, between Globe Avenue and Tuller Avenue
- Crews will also replace 47 services and install eight new fire hydrants within the project's boundaries.
- The project is scheduled to begin April 5, 2021, and should be completed in October 2021. Construction will take place from Monday to Friday, between the working hours of 8 am and 4 pm. Construction crews may begin arriving to the site beforehand, but no work will begin before 8 am. No work is scheduled for holidays.
- Traffic and parking may be impacted during construction working hours. There may be temporary street closures; however, alternative routes will be available. Residents will be notified in advance if access to driveways may be limited for short durations of time.
- Residents in the immediate vicinity of construction may experience increased levels of noise. Crews will make every effort to keep dust and noise to a minimum.
- Weekly activities such as trash pickup will not be interrupted.

Golden State Water appreciates the community's patience as it completes this important project. Proactive system maintenance has always been an emphasis for Golden State Water, as the company continually invests to upgrade both treatment and delivery systems in all service territories.
