**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. The company shall not be required to install new mains to make this service available.
3. The annual service charge will be paid in advance and bills will be computed and rendered monthly based on the total quantity of water delivered.
4. This service is limited to existing irrigation customers of record who irrigate all or a majority of their property, five acres or more in size, each and every year for citrus or other commercial crops.
5. Service under this schedule is subordinate to all other service schedule offered in this tariff area and is subject to interruptions in emergencies or at the Company's discretion. The Company will not be liable for damage occasioned by interruption of service supplied under this schedule.
6. The customer will pay, without refund, the actual cost of the irrigation service if a new or replacement service is needed. The company will furnish the meter at its expense.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.147 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customers' bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.045 per Ccf based on an 18-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on May 1, 2025 as indicated in Advice Letter 1958-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account. (I)
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D.23-06-024, an amount of \$0.264 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 36-months, beginning on October 10, 2025. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2022 through July 30, 2023.
10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.031 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Basin Pumping Rights Litigation Memorandum Account.
11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.001 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the CEMA - Emergency Disaster Relief Customer Outreach.

12. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.023 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the CEMA-COVID 19. (N)
13. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.018 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Public Safety Power Shut-Off Memorandum Account.
14. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.003 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Memorandum Account.
15. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.016 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the 2021 Water Conservation Memorandum Account.
16. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.014 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on February 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the balance in the Drinking Water Fees Balancing Account.
