APPLICABILITY

Applicable to metered irrigation water service except those covered under Schedules No. SM-1-R and Schedule SM-1-NR.

TERRITORY

The unincorporated area known as Lake Marie Ranches located in the former Lake Marie Service.

The Service Charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the monthly charge computed at the Quantity Rates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. A customer desiring to obtain water deliveries under this schedule must first obtain a written permit from the utility, with service limited to existing customers as of December 31, 1986. All outdoor irrigation must occur before 8 am or after 7 pm on specified watering day.
3. The utility will supply only such water pressure as may be available from time to time as a result of its normal operations.
4. Applicants requesting a new service connection, a new water meter or an increase in the size of their existing service connection and/or existing water meter resulting in increased demand within the Santa Maria Customer Service Area, as defined on the Service Area Maps, must provide a source of supplemental water to offset the increased water demand, pursuant to the Court adopted Stipulation in Santa Maria Valley Water Conservation District v. City of Santa Maria, et al. (and related actions), Lead Case No. CV 770214, Superior Court of the State of California, County of Santa Clara, in January 2008,
5. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.166 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CAP credit. This surcharge will offset the CAP credits and CAP administrative program costs recorded in the CAP Balancing Account.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

6. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.318 per Ccf based on an 18-month amortization period, is to be added to the Quantity Rate, beginning on May 1, 2025 as indicated in Advice Letter 1958-W. The surcharge may be recalibrated annually, if necessary. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account. (D)

7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.099 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on May 1, 2025. The surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and the final rates for the period of January 1, 2025 through January 31, 2025. (L)
8. Beginning January 1, 2026, as required by Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code, an increase in purchased water of \$5.483/Ccf relative to the purchased water adopted by Decision No. 25-01-036 and a decrease in purchased power of \$0.00023/kwh, relative to the purchased power adopted by approval of supply offset in Advice Letter 1965-W, and an associated revenue increase of 2.51%, are being tracked in a reserve account. (L)
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.2213 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on April 3, 2026. The surcharge recovers the balance in the MWRAM and ICBA. (N)
