Dear Mr. Shia:

In Resolution No. E-5076, the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) ordered Golden State Water Company (“GSWC”) to submit to the Water Division, on a quarterly basis, a report updating the Water Division on the status of the any Tribal Land Transfers. Specifically, Sections 5.1.a and 5.1.b of the Guidelines To Implement The CPUC Tribal Land Policy states,

*5.1.a The IOUs shall, every quarter, provide the Commission with 1) an updated list of recent real property dispositions; 2) a list of in-process real property dispositions; and 3) a summary of Tribal contacts and consultations (including the outcome of those consultations) they have undertaken over the previous quarter.*

*5.1.b These reports shall be due on January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1. If the due date falls on a weekend or holiday, the report shall be due the following business day.*

GSWC will be posting the attached report to its Tribal Land webpage on its website.

GSWC submits the attached report to the Commission for Quarter 2 in 2023, as directed.
